**Summary:** A very pretty, quiet and mainly off-road circular walk. From the railway station to the hospital is a lovely walk via the golf course (some steep parts) with fine views and woodland paths. From the hospital back to the station via Hady is through fields and lovely woodland with a short section along the main road and back along the river.

**Distance:** Approximately 3 miles (5 km) total though there are buses to / from the hospital.

**Time:** approx 2 hours (including rest stops)

**Accessibility:** Steep in parts and not suitable for pushchairs, wheelchairs or bicycles (though Dingle Lane is a nice bike route from Calow Lane to the hospital).

**3** Follow path uphill and across golf course.

**2** Cross Piccadilly Road, take narrow footpath on other side.

**1** Leave Railway Station and turn right under bridges.

**4** Take right-hand track past golf bunker and right fork at waymarker.

**5** Cross golf course on mound to footpath on other side.

**6** At main road turn left down quiet road and follow path past storage reservoir.

**7** Cross to road opposite and over grass.

**8** Follow path between car parks.

**9** Walk along road and take brideway opposite.

**15** Continue on footpath by river.

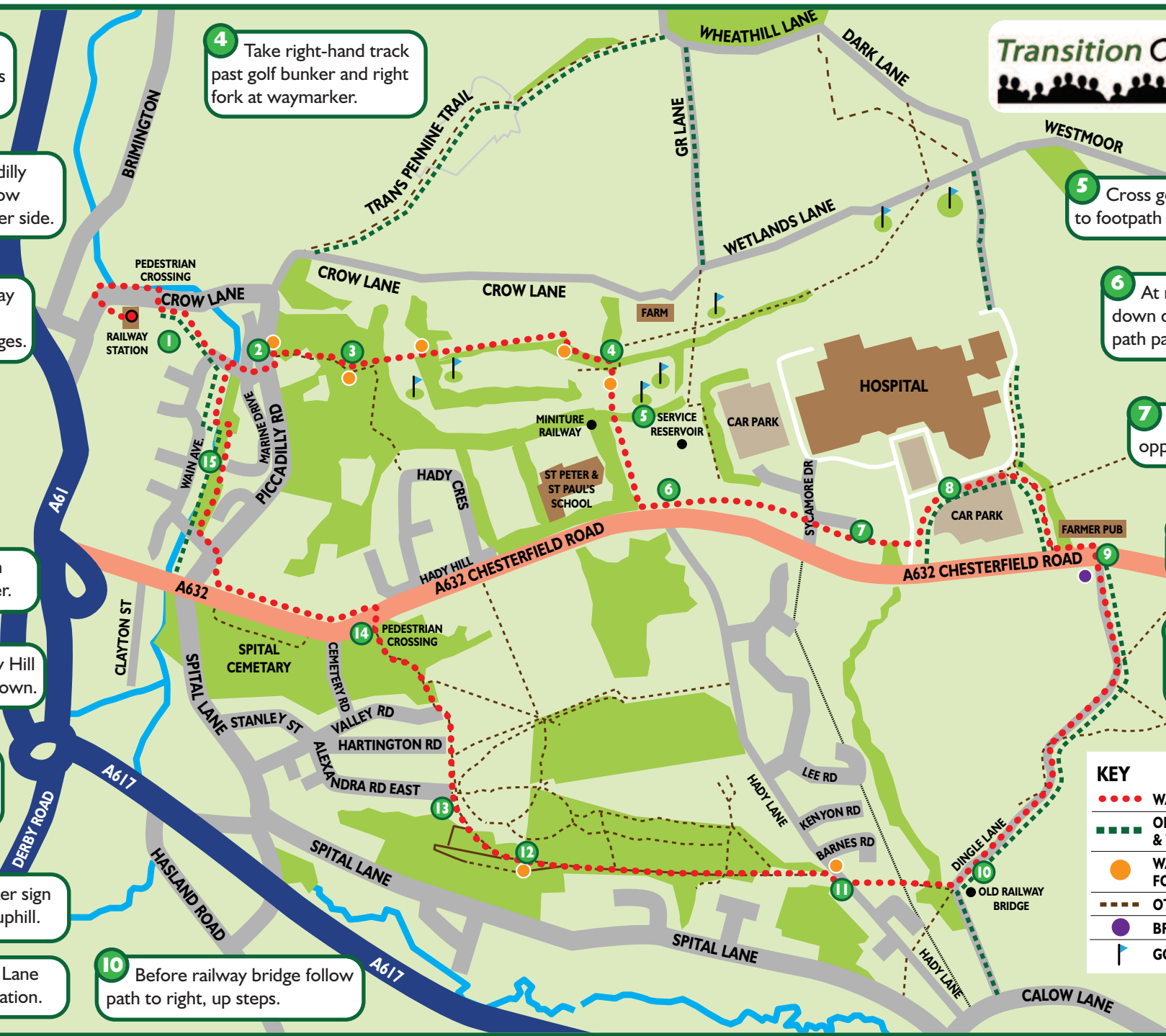
**14** Follow Hady Hill down towards town.

**13** Continue on path at top of three roads.

**12** At waymarker sign take right path uphill.

**11** Cross Hady Lane into Hady Plantation.

**10** Before railway bridge follow path to right, up steps.
