After printing fold in half lengthways then fold each outer square on top of the middle square

Use bus stops 1 and 2 (on the same side of the road as the river) to travel South; these are at each end of Matlock Bath; 1 is a few metres north of the river bridge to the railway station, 2 is across the road to the Fishpond hotel. From bus stops 1 and 2 catch the:

Transpeak (TP) to Cromford, Whatstandwell, Ambergate, Belper, Duffield and Derby. **6.1** ; Cromford Steeple Grange, Wirksworth, Belper, Duffield & Derby. **140** to Cromford, Lea, Holloway, Crich and Alfreton. **X17** to Cromford, Steeple Grange, Wirksworth. **Little 6.1** to Cromford, Middleton by Wirksworth & Wirksworth. **110/111** to Cromford, Steeple Grange, Wirksworth, Middleton Top, Hopton, Carsington and Ashbourne; some services call at Brassington, Bradbourne, Carsington Water and Hognaston, find all timetables at Derbyshire County Council's site www.derbybus.info

Tourists, alight at Cromford for Cromford Mills and the Cromford Canal, Steeple Grange for Black Rocks and the High Peak trail and Middleton top for the High Peak trail.

Bus stops 3 & 4 are for services heading to Matlock and beyond, find them across the road from the river. Bus stop 3 is near a prominent Church spire within the shops of North Parade, bus stop 4 is at the other end of Matlock Bath, by the Fishpond hotel.

From bus stops 3 & 4 catch **Transpeak (TP)** to Matlock, Darley Dale, Rowsley, Bakewell, Ashford in the Water, Taddington and Buxton. **6.1** to Matlock, Darley Dale, Rowsley and Bakewell. **X17** to Matlock, Kelstedge, Chesterfield and Sheffield, **Little 6, 140, 110 and 111** to Matlock only. **For timetables visit www.derbybus.info**

For trains, turn off the busy main road by 'The Midland' pub (which is near the public toilets) then cross the bridge and car park to the Railway Station. Trains depart for Matlock to the North, and also to: Cromford,

Whatstandwell, Ambergate, Belper, Duffield, DERBY, Spondon *Long Eaton, Attenborough *Beeston and NOTTINGHAM *Not all services stop at Spondon & Attenborough, please check with Trainline.com

'Derbyshire Connect' provides a service for all, covering an extensive area to the south-west of Matlock and picking up at Matlock Bath train station. Accessible buses (carrying prams, bikes and wheelchairs) will take you to beautiful villages which may no longer have bus services. Alfreton 46m Derbyshire Community Transport 140, via Cromford 3m, Lea Bridge 8m, Lea 10m, Holloway 12m, CRICH 24m, South Wingfield 36m, Oakerthorpe 40m. (Most buses carry on to Alfreton Railway Station (51m) check at www.derbybus.info)

WIRKSWORTH (10-15m), 6.1, Little 6.1, X17, 110/111. MIDDLETON BY WIRKSWORTH,(Little 6.1, 10m) (110/111 for Rise End & Middleton Top 10m)

BELPER by Train (20mins) TP (23mins) 6.1 (33min)

UTTOXETER (22m) STOKE ON TRENT (48m) CREWE (70m) approx. hourly by train.

Change bus in Buxton for Manchester airport (199) Earl Sterndale, Crowdecote, Warslow, Longnor, Hartington (442) Macclesfield (via Cat and Fiddle 58).
