



Transition Chesterfield's 'Walk of Shame' series*

No. 4: Crossing Foljambe Road, West Bars

Reason: Dangerous road crossing point, especially for children and people with limited mobility, on the main walking route from Chatsworth Road into town. There is a small central reserve only, with one of the feeder lanes off West Bars roundabout always open to traffic which often swing round at speed. All the other pedestrian crossings along that walking route along West Bars have traffic light controls but they are all quite slow and respond to the flow of vehicles, not pedestrians.
